

# Bracelet Free Crochet Pattern (UK terminology)

This pattern uses UK terminology. USA crocheters please note: UK double-crochet = USA single crochet

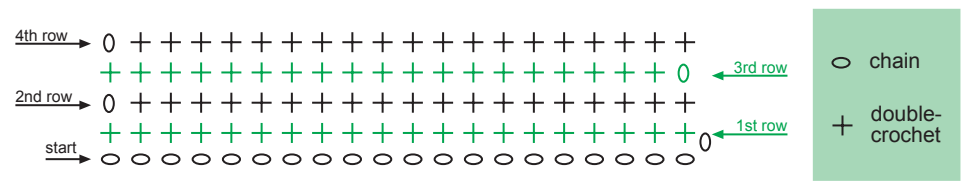
### Materials

Jaeger Albany or any double knitting yarn (approximately 10 metres/11 yards per bracelet)  
4.00 mm hook

### Abbreviations

dc = double-crochet

### Symbol chart



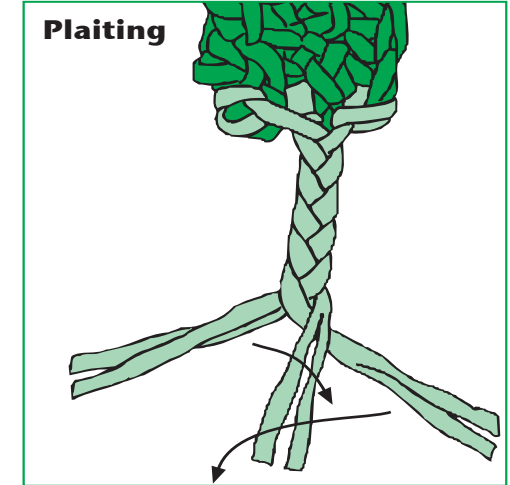
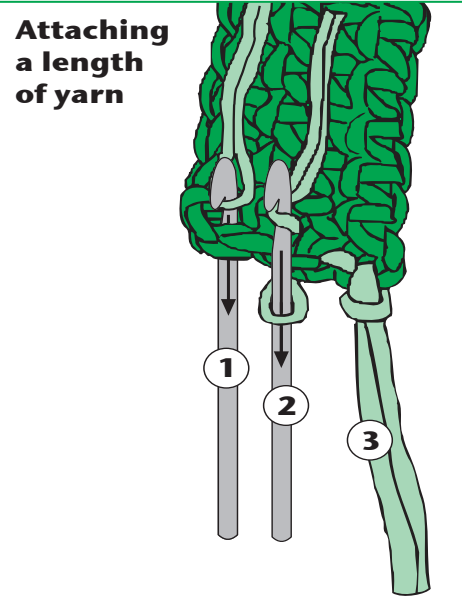
**Foundation chain** Chain 21.

**Row 1** 1 dc in 2nd chain from hook and in each chain to end. (20 stitches)

**Rows 2 — 4** Chain 1. Turn. 1 dc in each stitch to end. Fasten off.

### Making up

Cut six lengths of yarn 45 cm (18") long. Use your hook to attach three lengths of yarn to each end of the bracelet (see diagram). Plait (braid) the lengths of yarn together and tie knot in the end to secure plait. Use the plaits to tie the bracelet to your wrist.



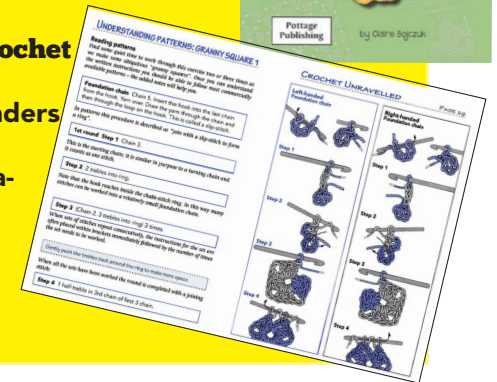
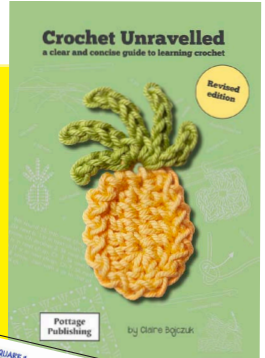
Pass left thread over middle thread. The left thread is now in the middle. Then pass right thread over the new middle thread. Repeat these two steps.

# Hair Scrunchie Free Crochet Pattern (UK terminology)



## Pottage Publishing

This pattern uses UK terminology. USA crocheters please note: UK double-crochet = USA single crochet

### Materials

Jaeger Albany or any double knitting yarn (ribbon yarn works well). Approximately 10 metres/11 yards per scrunchie.  
1 x 5 cm (2") diameter hairband 4.00 mm hook

### Abbreviations

dc = double-crochet

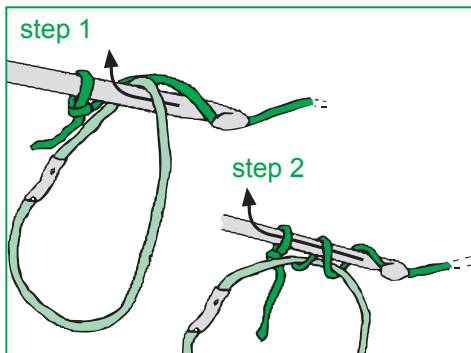
### Hair Scrunchie

**1st round** Join yarn to band with a dc (see diagram). Chain 2. (1 dc into band. Chain 2) 14 times. 1 dc in band. Join with a treble to first dc. (16 dc and 16 loops).

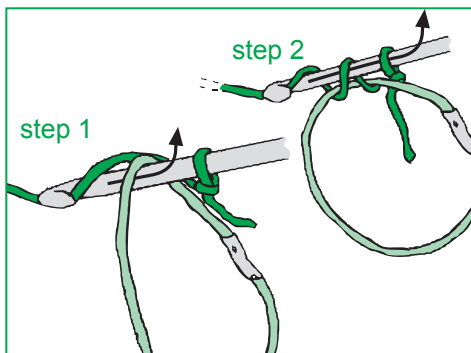
**2nd round** Chain 1. 1 dc in same space. (Chain 3. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next chain-space.) 15 times. Join with a treble to first dc. (16 dc and 16 loops).

**3rd round** Chain 1. 1 dc in same space. \*4 trebles in next dc. 1 dc in next chain-space. Chain 3. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next chain-space.\* Repeat from \* to \* 6 times. 4 trebles in next dc. 1 dc in next chain-space. Chain 3. Join with a slip-stitch to first dc. Fasten off.

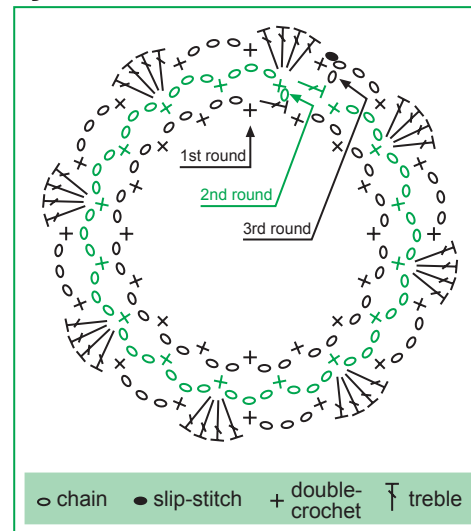
### Joining yarn to band left-handed
